

**PLAYER/PARENT AGREEMENT
2007 - 2008**

Athletics at St. Rita are a Parish sponsored activity enabling all parishioners to participate. As a parent of a participant in Racine Parochial Athletics, I agree to abide by, and ensure that my child abides by, Archdiocesan regulations and guidelines pertaining to athletics.

- 1. I verify that my son/daughter_____ is and will remain a member of one team, and one team only, in each sport per sport season (for example... is a member of only one basketball team including other leagues during basketball season).**
- 2. I further verify that my child has had a physical examination (which documentation of I have or will provide) within the past 20 months, and has medical clearance to participate in parochial athletics.**
- 3. I also verify that my child possesses insurance covering participation and travel in all parish/school-sponsored sports.**
- 4. I further agree that I will abide by the requirements and rules stipulated in St. Rita's policy for participation in School and Parish sponsored Activities and Athletics. If necessary I will work with the Principal or Director of Religious Education to correct any issues.**
- 5. I further agree to work at least:
 - a. 1 shift per child/athlete, during our volleyball tournament, regardless of our school service hours.**
 - b. 2 shifts per child/athlete, during our basketball tournament, regardless of our school service hours.****
- 6. I understand that any concerns I have relating to a sport should first be addressed to the coach then to the Athletic Committee.**
- 7. I understand that if my child is on a split team, RPAL regulation Section 9 stipulates how the split will be handled:**

When a school/parish decides to form two teams at one grade level, they must divide the **talent and **number** of athletes on the teams equally. A difference of 5 or more**

games in basketball or 15 or more games in volleyball in final league standing will create indication that the division of talent was not equal. The RPAL Executive Committee will review such cases. **Teams found to be in violation by the Executive Committee will forfeit league titles and eligibility in member or Archdiocese sponsored tournaments.** Also, if a team is found to be in violation they will be required to make necessary roster changes in order to remedy the situation. These changes must be submitted to the appropriate Commissioner. These changes must be approved by the Executive Committee before the roster delivery deadline.
